The Board previously awarded contracts to West Virginia University (WVU) and the University of California, Riverside (UCR) to conduct in-use emissions testing and evaluate retrofit technologies of on-road heavy-duty engines. The Port of Los Angeles (POLA), and the Port of Long Beach (POLB) have expressed interest in cofunding \$XX to test XX additional heavy-duty drayage vehicles. This action is to execute an agreement with POLA and POLB to recognize their funding and to amend the existing contracts with WVU and UCR to conduct the in-use testing and demonstration program. 7599. Recognize Revenue and Execute Contracts for Zero Emission Goods Movement Demonstration Projects Miyasato/3249

The development and demonstration of zero emissions goods movement technologies has been identified as one of AQMD's priority projects for FY 2011-12. Staff is recommending three projects which are consistent with this priority. These projects include the demonstration of Linear Synchronous Motor (LSM) technology to move cargo containers and the development of two discrete hybrid electric drive systems for Class 8 vehicles. This action is to recognize upon receipt \$3,000,000 from the Ports of Long Beach and Los Angeles, provide \$3,000,000 from the Rule 1309.1 Priority Reserve Fund, and execute a contract with General Atomics for the demonstration of an LSM container movement system at a total cost not to exceed \$7,500,000 from the Rule 1309.1 Priority Reserve Fund contingent upon receiving \$1,500,000 from other funding sources. In addition, this action is to execute contracts with Volvo for the development of a plug-in hybrid electric Class 8 vehicle at a cost not to exceed \$1,200,000 and with Meritor for the development of a hybrid electric Class 8 vehicle at a cost not to exceed \$2,750,000 from the Clean Fuels Fund.
