RULE 700

- 1 **VIOLATION OF RULES:** Every person violating any Order, Rule, or Regulation of the Butte County Air Pollution Control District (DISTRICT) or Hearing Board is guilty of a misdemeanor. Every day during any portion of which such a violation occurs is a separate offense.
- 2 **VIOLATION OF ORCHARD HEATER OR OPEN BURNING REGULATIONS:** Any violation of the provisions of Regulation III of these Rules and Regulations is a misdemeanor and subject to penalties pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Sections 42400, 42400.1, 42400.2, and 42400.5.
- 3 **CITATIONS:** The Air Pollution Control Officer or his designated representative is authorized to issue citations to any person violating any Order, Rule or Regulation of the DISTRICT.
- 4 **VIOLATIONS OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT, PERMIT TO OPERATE, AND BURN PERMIT CONDITIONS**
 - 4.1 Construction or operation of any source in violation of the terms or conditions of permits issued pursuant to these Rules is prohibited.
 - 4.2 Any violation of the terms or conditions of an Authority to Construct or permit issued pursuant to DISTRICT Rules shall constitute a violation of DISTRICT Rules.
