**WHAT IS A TSA?:** A technical system audit (TSA) is a review and evaluation of an ambient air monitoring program to assess the monitoring program’s compliance with established regulations governing the collection, analysis, validation, and reporting of ambient air quality data.

A TSA is conducted in three phases:

- Questionnaire
- On-site visit
- Written appraisal
