AB 2588 AIR TOXICS “HOT SPOTS” PROGRAM

Preface

The Air Toxics “Hot Spots” Information and Assessment Act of 1987 (AB 2588) is a State of California public right-to-know law requiring local air quality management and air pollution control districts to collect information about the location, type, and quantity of toxic compounds emitted into the air from specified local businesses and industry. The AB 2588 Program Annual Report is published to provide the public with information regarding the AB 2588 Program of the Butte County Air Quality Management District (District). The enabling statutes (California Health & Safety Code (HSC) Sections 44300-44394) require the California Air Resources Board (CARB) and local air districts to implement the “Hot Spots” Program. This report describes the current reporting and evaluation status for facilities being tracked under this program. This annual report is required by California HSC Section 44363.

INTRODUCTION

The goals of the AB 2588 Program are to collect emission data, to identify facilities having localized impacts, to ascertain health risks, and to notify nearby residents of significant risks.

The Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Information and Assessment Act of 1987 (AB 2588) requires certain emitters of airborne toxic compounds to submit toxic emissions inventory reports and updates. Facilities meeting Board-specified criteria must also complete health risk assessments. AB 2588 further requires the District to prepare an annual report summarizing progress on the implementation of the program.

HSC Section 44363 requires that the District Board conduct a public hearing concerning the subject report which must include information on the following:

- 1) The prioritization of facilities for the purpose of performing a health risk assessment for air emissions of listed substances;
- 2) The ranking and identification of facilities according to the degree of cancer risk posed to surrounding receptors;
- 3) The identification of facilities which expose individuals or populations to any non-cancer health risks; and

- 4) The status of development of control measures to reduce emissions of toxic air contaminants, if any.

AIR TOXICS “HOT SPOTS” PROGRAM

The AB 2588 Program (HSC Sections 44300 et seq.) established a process to compile an inventory of air toxics emissions from specified facility categories in California and to assess the potential risks to public health as a result of exposure to those emissions. AB 2588 also requires that the public be notified of facilities whose emissions pose significant health risks. AB 2588 specifies activities that the CARB, the Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA), and the districts must carry out to implement the Act. CARB is required to adopt a fee recovery regulation to assess fees on facilities subject to the requirements to ensure that costs to implement and administer the AB 2588 Program. (HSC Section 44380.)

This report addresses the statutory requirements of the AB 2588 Program. This report does not seek to address other toxics-related issues handled by staff. For example, the District also addresses air toxics exposures during permitting of new and modified sources of air pollutants. The source permitting process may require issuance of a public notice if the proposed source releases hazardous air pollutants within 1,000 feet of a school. The District also implements State Airborne Toxic Control Measures (ATCMs) and federal National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAPs). ATCM and NESHAP requirements are usually implemented through a source permit or equipment registration. The District has not developed control measures in addition to those required by an ATCM or NESHAP.

PROGRAM CATEGORIES OF DISTRICT FACILITIES

The District began implementing the AB 2588 Program in 1989. Facilities are categorized based on their reporting status in the program. Unless the District is performing an industry-wide survey for a facility category, facilities subject to the AB 2588 Program are required to file an emissions inventory plan and report with the local air district. The district reviews and approves the plan and reports, and based on the reported emissions, performs a prioritization evaluation (develops a prioritization score for the facility).

If the prioritization score indicates further evaluation is necessary the facility is required to perform a health risk assessment. If the results from the health risk assessment indicates a potential significant risk to the public, the facility is required to notify the public exposed to the emissions. A facility subject to the public notification requirement then must develop a risk reduction plan to lower the emissions below significance levels.

At this time there are no facilities identified in the District as posing a significant risk to the public.

As an alternative to this process, the facility or the District can conduct a health risk assessment as part of a permitting action, provided the results indicate any significant risk to the public.

After complying with the initial reporting requirements, based on the prioritization scores or health risk assessment results, facilities may be required to submit update reports every four years.

The following is a summary of the current facility update categories. The facilities are identified in the Facilities Status List, as included in Appendix B:

District staff are currently re-evaluating facility status as indicated on the list in Appendix B.

The above facility count may vary each year due to closures and /or addition of new facilities.

HEALTH RISK ASSESSMENTS

Since September 2009, the District completed 24 health risk assessments (HRAs) during the permitting process. These health risk assessments evaluate the health risk to the public due to toxic air emission from new or modified facilities. The health risks were below significance levels and the requested permits were issued by the District. These health risk assessments also satisfy the AB 2588 Program requirement for evaluating toxic air emissions. The health risk assessments were completed for the following facility categories:

- Stationary diesel engines: 3 health risk assessments
- Fumigation chambers: 2 health risk assessment
- Other facility types: 3 health risk assessments

The District oversaw the toxics source testing and performed a screening HRA for Pacific Oroville Power, Inc. located in Oroville, CA. POPI is the District’s largest source and had last been source tested for some toxic air contaminants in 2005 as part of the federal MACT standard evaluation but was lasted source tested in 1988 for most toxic volatile organic compounds. Since the original testing, different fuel types have been allowed at the facility. The District requested testing under the AB2588 protocols to evaluate potential toxic air contaminant emissions. This new testing was completed in November 2009. District staff witnessed the source testing and participated in the procedure to quantify foreign matter in the fuel blends. In summary, the source testing noted a net decrease in the total toxic air contaminant emissions and the screening HRA predicted less cancer risk for the facility since the last evaluation.

The District routinely performs HRAs using the AB 2588 guidelines and protocols for facilities not subject to the AB 2588 requirements; these assessments (typically for short-term soil remediation activities) are not included in the discussion above. HRAs during the coming year will be conducted as warranted.

DEVELOPMENT OF CONTROL MEASURES

During this report period, the District proposed and adopted amendments to Rule 1001, *Airborne Toxic Control Measure for Stationary Sources Used at Agricultural Operations*, to facilitate a low-use exemption that is protective of public health. The District processed approximately 50 registration requests for low use exemption and set the total allowable hours of operation to levels that would keep potential diesel particulate matter cancer risks to less than one in one million population at the nearest off-property receptor.

In addition, the District has performed outreach and permit actions to assist the removal and replacement of perchloroethylene dry cleaning machines. District dry cleaners removed 3 units from service and installed hydrocarbon systems to replace these units.

Also during this period, the District has worked with affected sources to comply with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAPs) at area sources. By State law, NESHAPs that do not have a corresponding Airborne Toxic Control Measure (ATCM) become ATCMs for the State. Area sources are smaller sources such as autobody shops, metal fabricators, paint manufacturers and various other spray coating operations.

AB 2588 PROGRAM FEES

Program costs may be recovered by assessing a fee to subject facilities pursuant to District Rule 506, *Air Toxics “Hot Spots” (AB 2588) Fees*. The District is required to pay a fee to the State to cover CARB’s costs. State fees are assessed by the District as a straight pass-through to the facility. The District is also authorized by Rule 506 to assess fees to cover local costs.

The AB 2588 assessment of State fees for Fiscal Year 2009-2010 was \$201. This amount was determined by CARB as follows:

SFPP, L.P.’s Chico Terminal = \$134.00 (Category F-Complex)
Pacific Oroville Power, Oroville = \$67.00 (Category F-Simple)

State costs are allocated among the districts using a formula considering the number of facilities in each of the program categories and resource indices and are based on facility data received from the districts by September 1, 2009.

Office hours are Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., except Tuesdays when the office opens at 8:30 a.m. Comments, statements, or arguments relating to the subject of this Notice may be presented orally or in writing at the hearing or with the District Board Clerk. APPENDIX B

Facility Status List

AB2588 Facility Status List Definitions

Facility = Name of facility

Facility Category = Tracking designation for facilities:

Core = a facility subject to the plan and reporting requirement that requires submittal of the five core components of the emission inventory report: Facility Information, Stack Information, Device Information, Process Information, and Emission Information, and are not part of an Industry-Wide Survey group

Exempt = facility is not subject to the regulation because of low priority score, less than 10 tons per year criteria pollutant emission and no toxics or below significance levels identified or risk assessment analysis

IWS-ABS = Industry-Wide Survey group for AutoBody Shops (Guidelines, Appendix E Source)

IWS-DCF = Industry-Wide Survey group for Dry Cleaning Facilities (Guidelines, Appendix E Source)

IWS-GDF = Industry-Wide Survey group for Gasoline Dispensing Facilities (Guidelines, Appendix E Source)

IWS-ICE = Industry-Wide Survey group for Diesel Internal Combustion Engines (Guidelines, Appendix E Source)

IWS-PS = Industry-Wide Survey group for Print Shops (Guidelines, Appendix E Source)

IWS-SBR = Industry-Wide Survey group for Ship Building and Repair (Guidelines, Appendix E Source)

Update Category = ranking of a facility based on the facility’s prioritization score, risk assessment, or other criteria for the purposes of updating the emissions inventory. A “high” priority facility is not necessarily a “high” risk facility. If a box is blank, the District is reviewing the program history of the facility or the facility is new to the program:

Exempt = A low-level facility with prioritization score less than 1, cancer risk less than 1, or non-cancer hazard index less than 0.1

Intermediate = Facility with prioritization score between 1 and 10, cancer risk between 1 and 10, or non-cancer hazard index between 0.01 and 1.0. Facility completes an update report every four years.

High = Facility with prioritization score greater than 10, cancer risk greater than 10, or non-cancer hazard index greater than 1.0. Staff evaluates whether facility completes an update plan and report or summary every four years.

NYP = Plan submitted, Not Yet Prioritized

(continued)**

State Fee Category = Organized by Category and then Complexity.

Categories are:

- A** = Prioritization score greater than 10 and no HRA performed
- B** = HRA performed and cancer risk between 10 and 50 per million, or Hazard Index is greater than 1
- C** = HRA performed and cancer risk is between 50 and 100 per million
- D** = HRA performed and cancer risk is greater than 100 per million
- E** = Unprioritized facility
- F** = “Tracking Facility” with a prioritization score of greater than 10 and HRA results for cancer risk is between 1 and 10 and/or non-cancer Hazard Index is greater than 1.
- IW** = Listed Industry-Wide Facility that has less than 10 tons per year of criteria pollutants (otherwise would be in a category above)
- Fee Exempt (G)** = “Exempt” Update category facility with prioritization score less than 10, HRA cancer risk less than 1 per million and Hazard Index less than 0.1—No fee

Complexity relates to the District determination of the size of the facility:

- Simple** = Small facility
- Medium** = Moderately sized facility
- Complex** = Largest facilities

Example: “F Simple” would mean a small tracking facility.

TS = Total facility Score—prioritization score for carcinogenic toxics determined in accordance with District policy

TS* = Total facility Score—prioritization score for non-carcinogenic toxics determined in accordance with District policy

HRA C/A/C = Health Risk Assessment -an evaluation of facility toxic air pollution by analyzing pollution control equipment and atmospheric modeling to predict health risks. First “C” value is for potential cancer risk in terms of chances per one million population. A cancer risk of less more than one (1) in one (1) million and less than ten (10) in one (1) million with Toxic Best Available Control Technology (TBACT) is generally accepted as not posing a significant risk to the exposed public. The “A” value is for the Hazard Index associated with acute or instantaneous health effects caused by the pollutants. The second “C” values is for the hazard index associated with chronic or long-term non-cancer health effects caused by the pollutants. A Hazard Index of less than one (1) is generally accepted as not posing a significant risk to the exposed public for both acute and chronic analyses.

strikeout = Facility closed. Maintained on list to track and update C
