Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Article 4 of Chapter 3, Part 4, Division 26 of the Health and Safety Code; and


Pursuant to the authority vested in the Executive Officer by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and pursuant to the authority delegated in accordance with Section 39516 of the Health and Safety Code;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That the Air Resources Board hereby certifies that the following grades of Aztech abrasives have been tested in accordance with "Method of Test for Abrasive Media Evaluation," Test Method Number California 371-A and found to comply with Section 92520 of Title 17, California Administrative Code and are therefore approved for dry unconfined abrasive blasting:

Aztech II
Aztech III
Aztech IV

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED: That this certification shall expire September 30, 1981 unless these abrasives can be shown prior to that date to still be in compliance with Section 92520 of Title 17, California Administrative Code in which case a subsequent Executive Order shall be issued extending the effectiveness of this certification.
