Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Article 4 of Chapter 3, Part 4, Division 26 of the Health and Safety Code; and


Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That the Air Resources Board hereby certifies that the following grades of 5280 RDM Enterprises abrasives have been tested in accordance with "Method of Test for Abrasive Media Evaluation," Test Method No. California 371-A and found to comply with Section 92520 of Title 17, California Administrative Code, and are therefore approved for dry unconfined abrasive blasting:

Ferro-Blast

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that this certification shall expire March 1, 1984 unless these abrasives can be shown prior to that date to still be in compliance with Section 92520 of Title 17, California Administrative Code, in which case a subsequent Executive Order shall be issued extending the effectiveness of this certification.
