

# Overview

- 2,540 bills and resolutions introduced
- 901 (39%) bills to Governor
- 805 bills signed (89%)
- 251 air quality and climate change bills and resolutions tracked
- 8 special hearings and 2 town halls

# Funding and Incentives

- Incentives for cleaner vehicles and equipment
- Cap-and-Trade auction proceeds
- Proposition 39



# Clean Air Incentives

- AB 8 (Perea): Extends fees until January 1, 2024
- AB 101 (Budget): \$24.55M for CVRP
- SB 359 (Corbett): \$48M for AB 118 programs
- SB 459 (Pavley): EFMP
- AB 266 (Blumenfield): HOV Lanes
- SB 286 (Yee): HOV Lanes

*All signed!*

# Electric Vehicle Infrastructure

- 6 bills on electric vehicle infrastructure
- 3 signed by the Governor
- AB 8 (Perea): Dedicates up to \$20M annually to establish a hydrogen fueling network
- SB 454 (Corbett): Interoperability standards
- AB 1092 (Levine): Building standards

# Cap-and-Trade and Prop 39

- Cap-and-Trade: 18 bills total
  - Auction proceeds (11 bills)
  - WCI, Inc. (3 bills)
  - “California First”
  - 1 bill signed: SB 726 (Lara)
- Proposition 39: 10 bills total
  - Dedicates funds for energy efficiency projects for schools
  - 1 bill signed: SB 73 (Budget)
