We are pleased to inform the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District (District) that the Air Resources Board (ARB) is now able to release project funds from the October 2009 sale of Build America Bonds, plus initial administrative funds, to support the Proposition 1B: Goods Movement Emission Reduction Program projects listed below:

Although the project funding listed above is coming from the sale of the Build America Bonds that limit expenditures to capital costs only, ARB is using some of the administrative funding we received in late 2009 for our own operations to provide each local agency with the initial administrative funding for each grant agreement as listed below. ARB's ability to pay the final administrative funding is dependent on the sale of appropriate, additional bonds. We are actively seeking these funds for local agencies.


