
Prop 1B: Goods Movement Emission Reduction Program



- \$1 billion to reduce emissions/risk in heavily impacted communities
- Achieve early or extra reductions by upgrading or replacing diesel equipment used for freight transportation in four priority trade corridors
- Priority on diesel PM and NOx; with co-benefits for climate

Program Funding to Date*

Emission Reductions: 2,200 tons PM 2.5 + 75,000 tons NOx



^{*}Includes funds for local agency and ARB's administration costs.

Funds to be Reallocated

- Total unspent funds: ~\$47 million
- Year 4 applications to reallocate unspent funds
- Executive Officer authority
 - Minor revision to Program Guidelines
 - Reversion of \$.7 million

- Zero and near-zero emission advanced technologies
- Small truck fleets
- Tier 4 locomotives
