- Communication Tool
  - Three stakeholders
    - Land Management Agencies
      - Federal, state, local
    - Air Quality Regulators
      - CARB, Air Districts
    - Public

# What is PFIRS?



- Communication Tool (cont'd)
  - Map of current projects
    - What burns are planned?
    - What burns were occurring?
  - Where is smoke coming from?
    - If public observes smoke, they can look at the map and see if it's coming from a prescribed burn

# Who's Involved?



- PFIRS users
  - 200+ land manager users
  - 60 air district users
  - 25 of 35 air districts represented
  - Training sessions planned as funding allows

# Current PFIRS Issues



- Map Uploading
  - Some problems with PDF files
- Unit Template Spreadsheet
  - USFS users are seeing a screen full of junk characters
- Server Migration
  - PFIRS server has been moved to a new location
  - Some minor glitches were encountered but were fixed

# New PFIRS Features



- Remove or deactivate your account
  - If you are retiring or leaving smoke management, you can transfer your SMPs and remove or deactivate your PFIRS account
- Transfer SMPs from old users
  - SMPs from old users can be reassigned to current users
- Transfer SMPs when changing jobs
  - When updating your account information, you will be able to transfer your SMPs to someone in your previous position

# Fire Information Map



- Webcams
  - 1000+ webcams
  - Checked about once per week
- Air Quality
  - AQMIS ozone and PM2.5 data
- Download KMZ
  - All overlays are contained in one file you can use on your desktop Google Earth
