- * Wildfire and/or Smoke Dispersion Maps
- * Links to additional smoke/fire information
- * Comments are moderated
- * Links to appropriate information

How Posts should Look

- * Titles easy to read
- * Day and date are first in the title of the post
- * Graphics should all be “extra-large”
- * Google Chrome, Firefox, and Safari browsers are best
- * Internet Explorer has issues and limitations

Information Content

- * Information should be timely and consistent
- * Prominent wildfire events may have more information and more posting by different authors
- * Preview your post to ensure it appears as intended

Comments on a Post

- * No designated personnel to respond to comments
- * Agency that posted may be best to respond
- * Feedback from the 1400 call may help in responding to comments




