## Background

Last summer DEODC conducted an investigation of geothermal gases in the Burns Valley School neighborhood of Clearlake. The purpose of this work was to better understand potential health threats to the local community. Methods included soil gas sampling, indoor air sampling and ambient air measurements. This work builds on previous efforts by US EPA, ARB, Lake County Public and Environmental Health Departments, and the local APCD.
