Regulation for the Mandatory Reporting of Greenhouse Gas Emissions Advisory

COST OF IMPLEMENTATION FEE REGULATION REPORTING DEADLINE EXTENSION TO CONFORM WITH THE MANDATORY REPORTING REGULATION DEADLINE EXTENSION FOR ELECTRIC POWER ENTITIES AND ABBREVIATED REPORTERS SUBJECT TO THE JUNE 1, 2016 DEADLINE

The purpose of this advisory is to announce that the California Air Resources Board (ARB) is granting an extension to June 8, 2016, for electric power entities and abbreviated reporters subject to the Cost of Implementation Fee Regulation, title 17, California Code of Regulations, section 95200 et seq. (Fee Regulation), that received a June 1, 2016, deadline extension to the for reporting of 2015 data submitted to ARB in 2016 under the Regulation for the Mandatory Reporting of Greenhouse Gas Emissions, title 17, California Code of Regulations, section 95100 et seq. (MRR).

Current Action

This Regulatory Advisory further extends the Fee Regulation reporting deadline from June 1, 2016 to June 8, 2016, for electric power entities and abbreviated reporters that did not complete the submission and certification of their emissions data reports prior to May 27, 2016, and pertains to 2015 data reported in 2016. Entities that completed the submission and certification process prior to May 27, 2016, were not affected by the unforeseen technical issue, and do not require an extension to the reporting deadline.
