These maps can be used to geographically evaluate whether projects are located in or provide benefits to disadvantaged communities. For more information on how these maps apply to disadvantaged community benefits please see Appendix 2.A of the Funding Guidelines for Administering Agencies.¹

HALF-MILE ZONES

Projects may be considered to benefit disadvantaged communities if –

- **Located Within:** The project is located in the census tract and it meets the criteria provided in Appendix 2.A of the Funding Guidelines for “Step 1 – Located Within;” **OR**
- **Provides Benefits To:** The project is located in the half-mile zone around a census tract and it meets at least one of the following criteria provided in Appendix 2.A for “Step 2 - “Provides Benefits To.”

The following project types have criteria based on half-mile zones:


	The blue areas represent census tracts that have been identified as disadvantaged communities.
