Dear Sir or Madam:

The Air Resources Board (ARB) staff invites you to participate in a public workshop to discuss development of a statewide 1990 greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions level and mandatory GHG reporting requirements. Both of these actions are requirements of the California Global Warming Solutions Act (AB 32, Statutes of 2006, chapter 488). The 1990 GHG emissions level sets the GHG emissions limit to be achieved by 2020. Staff will also share initial proposals on mandatory reporting and verification requirements for facilities. Updates will be provided from technical discussions on calculation methodologies for the electric power, cement, and oil refining sectors. Staff will also present a proposal for reporting by other large stationary combustion sources. Interested parties will have the opportunity to comment on proposals and provide other ideas to ARB staff. An additional workshop is tentatively being considered for July 2007.
