Request for Nominations to fill vacancies of the Global Warming Environmental Justice Advisory Committee

The California Air Resources Board (ARB) requests nominations of individuals to fill vacancies of the Global Warming Environmental Justice Advisory Committee (EJAC). The Committee was established as part of the California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006 (AB 32; Statutes of 2006, chapter 488). The function of EJAC is to advise the Board in developing the Scoping Plan, and any other pertinent matter in implementing AB 32. AB 32 requires that the Board appoint the Committee members from nominations received from environmental justice organizations and community groups.

Nominations will be accepted through December 14, 2007. EJAC members will be appointed at the January 24, 2007 meeting of the Board. Based on the nominations received, ARB will balance the membership of EJAC in consideration of diversity, geographic representation, and experience.
