GreenPlumbers is presenting Climate Care workshops in California now. We believe our Climate Care program fits with the Cleantech Workforce Training program. We are interested in adapting our current curriculum to further enhance the goals of the Air Resources Board. To date, we have completed 9 workshops and have retrained 170 plumbers. Our goal is to retrain 15,000 plumbers in California, and 40,000 across the country. We are currently adapting our climate care curriculum from Australia's program to include Solar and HVAC. We believe that any "savings accountable" Cleantech training program should include Plumbing, Solar and HVAC.

There are only two ways to get back to the 1990 levels, as discussed in AB 32. Reduce the energy consumption of our society, or replace what we do with renewables. The primary goal of GreenPlumbers is to reduce the energy consumption of our society. In California, the water use cycle accounts for 19% of the energy used. The majority of electricity used related to water is added by end users. GreenPlumbers sole focus is the end users - and reducing their consumption to save energy and water.

GreenPlumbers mission is to train plumbers to be part of the solution. One retrained plumber goes into 3+ homes a day reducing water and energy in each home. They instantly become the point of contact with consumers to get the message across. If one GreenPlumber goes into 3 homes a day, 5 days a week, they will have entered 750 homes in one year. Once we retrain 1,000 plumbers, that in turn is 750,000 homes that will have not only fixture changes to reduce consumption, but behavioral changes as well. We are essentially sending a green army into homes across the State.

In GHG reductions related to buildings -
If retrained plumbers do their job they will do two things:
Save energy in houses
Save energy attached to the water cycle itself.

We want plumbers to become the home water and energy conservation champion, and to be the experts on emerging technologies and products, so that they can influence the purchasing decisions of householders for the benefit of society.
