Joshua Cunningham is the Branch Chief of the Sustainable Transportation Technology Branch within the Air Resources Board. Joshua has been with the Air Resources Board for over six years contributing to a number of advanced vehicle and emission reduction programs. He spent his first few years working on the ZEV regulation update focusing on technology feasibility and environmental benefits. Complementing this regulatory experience, Joshua helped launch the Plug-in Electric Vehicle Collaborative, addressing market barriers to the emerging ZEV sales. In the past two years, Joshua has been the manager of the Transportation Planning Section, leading the development and use of the ARB Vision scenario planning tool. The Vision program has been instrumental in further analysis of the role of ZEVs light-duty and heavy-duty applications.
