Regulation for the Mandatory Reporting of Greenhouse Gas Emissions Advisory SSD 14-04

COST OF IMPLEMENTATION FEE REGULATION DEADLINE EXTENSION TO CONFORM WITH THE MANDATORY REPORTING REGULATION DEADLINE EXTENSION FOR REFINERIES SUBJECT TO THE APRIL 10, 2014 DEADLINE

The purpose of this advisory is to announce that the California Air Resources Board (ARB) is granting an extension to May 16, 2014, for refineries subject to the Cost of Implementation Fee Regulation, title 17, California Code of Regulations, section 95200 et seq. (Fee Regulation), that received a deadline extension, for the reporting of new and updated product data reporting requirements under the Regulation for the Mandatory Reporting of Greenhouse Gas Emissions, title 17, California Code of Regulations, section 95100 et seq. (MRR).

Background

ARB first approved MRR in 2007 and the Fee Regulation in 2010. Under section 95204(c)(3) of the California Code of Regulations, entities subject to the Fee Regulation must report by April 10th, consistent with MRR reporting deadlines contained in section 95103(e).

In 2013, ARB initiated a rulemaking to amend the MRR. The amendments became effective January 1, 2014, and included new and updated product data reporting requirements for refineries (section 95113(l)) to support the allocation of allowances under the Cap-and-Trade Program. In an earlier Regulatory Advisory, SSD 14-02, ARB extended the reporting deadline for certain entities covered by these requirements to May 9, 2014.

Current Action

This Regulatory Advisory further extends the Fee Regulation reporting deadline from April 10, 2014 to May 16, 2014, for refineries subject to Fee Regulation and for which MRR requires new or updated product data reporting for 2013 data reported in 2014. This is the same group of reporters for whom the MRR reporting deadline has extended under Regulatory Advisory, SSD 14-03.
