Project Title: **REGIONAL GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSION REDUCTION TARGETS FOR AUTOMOBILES AND LIGHT TRUCKS PURSUANT TO SENATE BILL 375 (SCH# 2010081021)**

Project Location: Statewide, namely jurisdictions within 18 Metropolitan Planning Organizations throughout the State.

Project Description: Senate Bill 375 (Steinberg, Chapter 728, Statutes of 2008) directed the Air Resources Board (ARB) to set regional greenhouse gas emission reduction targets for passenger vehicles and light trucks for 2020 and 2035. The targets are for the 18 MPOs in California. The targets adopted are set forth in the Executive Order No. G-11-024

No feasible mitigation measures were identified that could be incorporated into the project and no mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted.


A statement of overriding considerations was adopted for the project.
