## Scoping Plan Workshop Series California Global Warming Solutions Act - AB 32 —Sector-Based Overview—

### **Invitation to Attend the Second Public Workshop on the Scoping Plan**

The Air Resources Board (ARB) staff invites you to participate in a public workshop to discuss the Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Scoping Plan (Plan) required by the California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006, also known as Assembly Bill 32 (AB 32). This workshop will offer a broad overview and profile of GHG emitting sectors and examples of emission reduction measures.

### **Scoping Plan Background**

AB 32 requires the ARB to develop a Plan to achieve maximum technologically feasible and cost-effective reductions in greenhouse gases by 2020, and that the Board approve this Plan no later than January 1, 2009. This sector-based workshop will provide an overview of the sectors responsible for the largest percentage of greenhouse gas emissions, coupled with an overview of the staff's current thinking about potential emission reduction measures for the Scoping Plan as follows:

- Sector baseline emissions and sources,
- Overview of sector profiles,
- Examples of existing and potential greenhouse gas controls,
- Discussion of costs, and
- Examples of potential policy tools.

Subsequent workshops will discuss policy approaches to achieve emissions reduction, and possible scenarios for achieving the 2020 GHG reduction target and beyond.
