The California Air Resources Board, in cooperation with the Bay Area Air Quality Management District, is conducting modeling studies to estimate the health risks from diesel exhaust in West Oakland.

The studies will examine the impact of diesel emissions from ships, trucks, trains, and other sources.

This meeting is co-sponsored by the Air Resources Board, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District, and the Port of Oakland.

The meeting will provide an opportunity for the public to learn about the studies, ask questions, and provide input.

- Why these studies are being done
- What we expect to learn from the results
- What data are being used to understand diesel sources in West Oakland and how they operate
- How emissions will be estimated
- What health impacts will be quantified
