EXECUTIVE ORDER G-16-025

Portable Outboard Marine Tanks and Components

Supex Products Corp.
Portable Outboard Marine Tank Fuel Hose

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Health and Safety Code sections 39600, 39601 and 43013, the California Air Resources Board (ARB) has established a certification process for portable outboard marine tank fuel hoses as described in California Code of Regulations, title 13, section 2468.2;

WHEREAS, CP-510, *Certification Procedure for Portable Outboard Marine Tanks and Components*, adopted July 20, 2009, (hereinafter "Certification Procedure") incorporated by reference into Cal. Code Regs., title 13, section 2468.2, requires that an application for certification include test results demonstrating the portable outboard marine tank fuel hose does not exceed a permeation rate of 15 grams/m²/day;

WHEREAS, section 1 of the Certification Procedure provides that an executive order (EO) will only be issued for a portable outboard marine tank fuel hose that demonstrates compliance with all applicable certification requirements;

WHEREAS, section 5 of the Certification Procedure provides that ARB Executive Officer shall evaluate each application for certification of a portable outboard marine tank fuel hose to determine if the portable outboard marine tank fuel hose complies with the performance standards and administrative requirements for issuance of an EO;

WHEREAS, Supex Products Corp. submitted an application for certification of the Supex Products Corp. model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose;

WHEREAS, Supex Products Corp. submitted test data demonstrating the Supex Products Corp. model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose does not exceed a permeation rate of 15 grams/m²/day;

WHEREAS, Supex Products Corp.'s model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose certification application was evaluated and found to comply with the performance standards and administrative requirements for the issuance of an EO; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Health and Safety Code sections 39515 and 39516, ARB Executive Officer issued EO P-10-002 delegating to the Chief of ARB Monitoring and Laboratory Division (MLD) the authority to certify portable outboard marine tank components.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michael T. Benjamin, Chief of MLD, find that the Supex Products Corp. model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose conforms to the performance requirements set forth in Cal. Code Regs., title 13, section 2468, when tested in accordance with ARB Test Procedure TP-512.

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the Supex Products Corp. model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose identified in Table 1 is hereby certified to meet the performance standards and administrative requirements applicable to a portable outboard marine tank fuel hose for supply to original equipment manufacturers or as aftermarket products for introduction into commerce in California.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Supex Products Corp. shall provide a warranty to equipment manufacturers and aftermarket buyers purchasing the Supex Products Corp. model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose. The warranty must conform to the standards of section 2.5 of the Certification Procedure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that certified Supex Products Corp. model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose shall be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's installation and use instructions for Supex Products Corp. model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose. A copy of fuel hose installation and use instructions shall be provided to original equipment manufacturers and aftermarket parts suppliers purchasing Supex Products Corp. model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose for installation on portable outboard marine tank equipment introduced into commerce in California.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Supex Products Corp. model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose introduced into commerce in California shall be clearly identified by a permanent identification that allows ARB to determine the date of manufacture and EO number.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Supex Products Corp. must comply with the administrative requirements specified in Cal. Code Regs., title 13, section 2468.6 and must supply any changes to the permanent identification to the Executive Officer for review and approval at least three months prior to offering for sale a certified portable outboard marine tank fuel hose with changed identification.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that production fuel hose must be in all material respects the same as those for which certification is granted and must meet all of the certification requirements. Any alteration of the components or design of the Supex Products Corp. model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose certified hereby is prohibited and inconsistent with this certification, unless said alteration has been approved in advance of production by the Executive Officer or his or her delegate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Supex Products Corp. model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose shall be compatible with fuels in common use in California at the time of certification and any modifications to comply with future California fuel requirements shall be approved in writing by the Executive Officer or his or her delegate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Executive Officer may enjoin sales, assess penalties, or revoke or modify this certification as provided in Cal. Code Regs., section 2468.9, if the Executive Officer determines that the Supex Products Corp. model GSPXPLINEFLB portable outboard marine tank fuel hose offered for sale or sold in California does not meet the "Certification and Compliance Performance Standards and Test Procedures for Portable Outboard Marine Tank Fuel Hoses and Portable Outboard Marine Tank Primer Bulbs" as provided in Cal. Code Regs., title 13, section 2468.2.
