Table 1. Categories proposed for new VOC standards. *Note:* category name does not necessarily correspond to a survey category.

Category Name	Comment
Adhesive Remover	Possible definition addition or change; evaluating whether reactivity or mass-based reduction strategy is most appropriate; evaluating issues with chlorinated or toxic compounds.
Anti-Static Product	
Body Wipes	Evaluating subcategories.
Contact Adhesive	Reviewing definition and toxics in formulation.
Electronic Cleaner	Evaluating the use of toxics in formulation.
Fabric or Leather Waterproofer	Evaluating for consistency with existing "Fabric Protectant" standard.
Fabric Refresher	
Footwear Care Product	May combine with "Leather Care Product" category.
Graffiti Remover	Evaluating the use of toxics in formulation.
Hair Color Product: Temporary	May combine with definition of hairspray or set similar standard as a separate category.
Hair Styling Product	Combination of four survey categories, 31-Hair Styling Product: Liquid, 33-Hair Styling Product: Semisolid, 34- Hair Styling Product: Solid, and some of the non-finishing spray products in 35-Hair Styling Product: Spray. Each of the surveyed categories have many near zero VOC products.
Insect Repellent: non-aerosol	
Leather Care Product	May combine with "Footwear Care Product" category.
Multi-purpose Remover	Listed as "multi-purpose solvent" in the Regulation; Possible definition addition or change to clarify separation between "packaged solvents;" Continue to evaluate feasibility of both mass-based or reactivity reduction control strategy.
Nail Coatings	Definition will most likely combine these survey categories: 41-Nail Polish, 45-Top Coat, 40-Base Coat/Undercoat, and 44-Nail Treatment Product.
Packaged Solvents	Add regulatory definition; Continue to evaluate the feasibility of a reactivity reduction control strategy.

Toilet or Urinal Cleaner	May combine all three survey categories: 46-Toilet or Urinal Cleaner, 47-Toilet or Urinal Deodorizer, and 48-Toilet/Urinal Cleaner and Deodorizer.

Toilet/Urinal Cleaner and Deodorizer	May combine all three survey categories: 46-Toilet or Urinal Cleaner, 47-Toilet or Urinal Deodorizer, and 48-Toilet/Urinal Cleaner and Deodorizer.

Category Name	Comment
General Purpose Degreasers	Possible definition changes to avoid overlap with other solvent categories; Evaluating potential issues with chlorinated or toxic compounds.
Hair Mousse	May amend definition to make consistent with a foam definition.
Hairspray	Broaden definition to include those sprays using compounds other than resin and those products generally intended to be a holding, finishing spray product for hair. Exclude products reported in 35-Hair Styling Product: Spray, that are styling products with no finishing claims.
Solvent Parts Cleaners Non-aerosol	Already combined with “general purpose degreasers” in Mid-Term Measures II Amendments; see “general purpose degreaser” comments.
