The staff of the California Air Resources Board (ARB/Board) invites you to participate in a public workshop to discuss proposed amendments to California's consumer products regulations. At this workshop, we will discuss staff's proposed new or modified definitions, other regulatory language modifications, proposed new or modified volatile organic compound limits, proposed limitations on the use of specific toxic compounds, and proposed changes to ARB Test Method 310. We will also discuss potential mitigation measures to ensure use of greenhouse gas emissions does not increase. In addition, we will present, for discussion, product labeling concepts. These proposed amendments are consistent with ARB's 2007 State Implementation Plan for Ozone and are necessary to help California meet its commitment to attain ambient air quality standards.


