## Public Workshop on Proposal to Reduce Volatile Organic Compounds and High-global Warming Potential Greenhouse Gases from Consumer Products

The California Air Resources Board (ARB/Board) invites you to participate in a public workshop to discuss the development of proposed modifications to California's consumer products regulations. At this workshop, we will discuss staff's proposed regulatory language modifications and proposed new volatile organic compound (VOC) and greenhouse gas (GHG) limits for specific categories of consumer products. We will provide you with background information, receive questions, and welcome your comments on our proposals.

Background. The proposed modifications are consistent with ARB's State Implementation Plan for Ozone and are necessary to help California meet its commitment to attain ambient air quality standards. In addition, the modifications address the "Discrete Early Action" item, "Reduction of High-Global Warming Potential GHGs Used in Consumer Products," as specified in ARB's Early Action Final Report, dated October 2007. The GHG proposal helps fulfill ARB's requirements under Assembly Bill 32, the California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006.


