**CHANGES SINCE PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING NOTICE:**

San Luis Obispo County APCD: *Since the workshop notice was distributed, staff has reviewed additional data for San Luis Obispo County from the U.S. EPA AIRS data system. Based on these additional data, San Luis Obispo County qualifies for redesignation to nonattainment-transitional for ozone by operation of law.*

Solano County portion of Yolo-Solano AQMD: *The workshop notice included a proposal to redesignate the Solano County portion of the Yolo-Solano AQMD to nonattainment-transitional, leaving the Yolo County portion of the District as nonattainment for ozone. However, on further examination of the designation criteria, it has been determined that a district area within one air basin cannot be split between two different designations. The Yolo-Solano AQMD is within one air basin (SVAB). As a result, the designation for Yolo-Solano AQMD remains unchanged (nonattainment for ozone).*
