The California Air Resources Board (ARB) staff invites you to participate in a public workshop to discuss possible regulatory approaches to reduce particulate matter (PM) emissions from new and existing diesel-fueled engines. This workshop will focus on the development of the proposed airborne toxic control measures (ATCMs) for stationary diesel-fueled engines and transport refrigeration units (TRUs). The stationary ATCM will be discussed in the morning followed by the TRU ATCM discussion in the afternoon (please see attached draft agenda). In January 2002 we held a public workshop to discuss the development of ATCMs for diesel-fueled engines used in stationary applications as well as a workgroup meeting concerning TRUs. At the workshop, we shared proposed regulatory concepts for reducing emissions from these applications. Since that time, we have been working to develop the draft regulatory language based on the concepts presented at the January meetings.
