## SEP IV Invoicing Instructions

1. The Purchase Order number should be the **fleet's vehicle ID**.
2. The PO should be addressed as follows:

**Ship To:**  
**"Fleet Name"**  
**(Address where vehicle is currently located)**

3. The ARB Data logger is ordered and installed by the device manufacturers, and should be added as a line item on the invoice. The data-logger selected by the ARB for the SEP program is made by **CPKAutomotive**. The part number is **20910\_CARB** and will cost no more than \$1,200 (please note this pricing and configuration is only available to SEP and Showcase participants during such programs. Any additional units for other purposes will be subject to different pricing).

Please note that once purchased, the data logger will be shipped to the ARB where it can be picked up for installation.

4. If any **additives** are necessary for proper function of the retrofit device a **1 year supply** of additive must be included.
5. Any and All applicable taxes must only be applied to parts or deliverable goods. **Labor should not be taxed.**
6. All device warranties must adhere to the Section 2707 of the **Verification Procedure, Warranty and In-Use Compliance Requirements for In-Use Strategies to Control Emissions from Diesel Engines**, and it should be stated on the invoice.
