Using the *Verification Procedure, Warranty, and In-Use Compliance Requirements for In-Use Strategies to Control Emissions from Diesel Engines*, Title 13, California Code of Regulations, Sections 2700-2711 (Procedure), staff of the Air Resources Board (ARB) has reviewed and approved IMPCO Technologies Canada, Incorporated's (IMPCO) request of update on parts list, engine family list, and labels to conditional verification number 14-944-1938 for the CLEARSKY Diesel Particular Filter (DPF) system.

Enclosed please find updated parts list, engine family list, and labels for IMPCO's CLEARSKY DPF system. ARB reminds you to include the Diesel Emission Control Strategies family name on all identification labels. No changes are permitted to the system as described in the conditional verification letter. IMPCO must ensure that each CLEARSKY DPF system is installed with a backpressure monitor that is clearly visible to the operator while the system is in use. Any changes to the system including but not limited to system components, system labels, system control logic, warning system, applicable models, model years, engine families, duty cycle, etcetera, must be evaluated and approved in writing by ARB. Failure to do so will result in the referral of the matter to ARB's Enforcement Division for appropriate action and may also result in ARB revoking or suspending the conditional verification.

Additionally, as stated in the Procedure, IMPCO is responsible for recordkeeping requirements (Section 2702), honoring a warranty (Section 2707) and conducting in-use compliance testing (Section 2709).


