

**COMPONENT SWAPPING AND RE-DESIGNATION POLICY FOR  
DCL INTERNATIONAL INCORPORATED'S (DCL) MINE-X SOOTFILTER®  
DIESEL PARTICULATE FILTER (DPF)**

**Relating to Executive Order DE-09-012-02**

Effective Date: November 21, 2012

Component Swapping means the movement of designated parts between different vehicles/applications utilizing the same diesel emission control strategy (DECS) as defined in the *Verification Procedure, Warranty, and In-Use Compliance Requirements for In-Use Strategies to Control Emissions from Diesel Engines* (the verification procedure or procedure) in Section 2701, Title 13, *California Code of Regulations*.

Re-designation means the removal, within the same common ownership fleet, of a complete used verified DECS from an appropriate engine in a vehicle/application and installation to another appropriate engine in a vehicle/application that meets the terms and conditions of the DECS Executive Order as defined in the *Procedure*.

No component swapping or re-designation is allowed for the Mine-X Sootfilter® DPF.

If component swapping or re-designation occurs, DCL may deny your warranty claim. Selling a used, verified, or conditionally verified DECS is not permitted.
