

SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY UNIFIED AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT

RULE 8041 -- CARRYOUT AND TRACKOUT

(Adopted November 15, 2001)

1.0 Purpose

The purpose of this rule is to limit fugitive dust emissions from carryout and trackout.

2.0 Applicability

This rule applies to all sites that are subject to Rules 8021 (Construction, Demolition, Excavation, Extraction, and other Earthmoving Activities), 8031 (Bulk Materials), and 8071 (Unpaved Vehicle and Equipment Traffic Areas) where carryout or trackout has occurred or may occur. The provisions of this rule shall be effective on and after May 15, 2002.

3.0 Definitions

The definitions of terms in Rule 8011 (General Requirements) shall apply to this rule.

4.0 Exemptions

In addition to the exemptions established in Rule 8011, the following exemption is also established for this rule.

4.1 Carryout and trackout caused by an Agricultural Source.

5.0 Requirements

An owner/operator shall sufficiently prevent or cleanup carryout and trackout as specified in sections 5.1 through 5.8. In addition to the requirements of this rule, a person shall comply with all other applicable requirements of Regulation VIII. The use of blower devices, or dry rotary brushes or brooms, for removal of carryout and trackout on public roads is expressly prohibited. The removal of carryout and trackout from paved public roads does not exempt an owner/operator from obtaining state or local agency permits which may be required for the cleanup of mud and dirt on paved public roads.

5.1 Owners/operators of sites not identified in Sections 5.2 through 5.5 shall remove all visible carryout and trackout at the end of each workday.

5.2 Within urban areas, if carryout and trackout extends less than 50 feet from the nearest exit point of a site, the owner/operator shall remove all visible carryout and trackout at the end of each workday.

- 5.3 An owner/operator of any site with 150 or more vehicle trips per day shall prevent carryout and trackout as specified in Section 5.8.
- 5.4 An owner/operator subject to the requirements of a Dust Control Plan as specified in Rule 8021 (Construction, Demolition, Excavation, Extraction, and other Earthmoving Activities) shall prevent carryout and trackout as specified in Section 5.8.
- 5.5 Within urban areas, an owner/operator shall prevent or immediately remove carryout and trackout when it extends more than 50 feet from the nearest exit point of a site.
- 5.6 For sites with paved interior roads, an owner/operator shall prevent carryout and trackout as specified in Section 5.8.
- 5.7 Cleanup of carryout and trackout shall be accomplished by:
 - 5.7.1 Manually sweeping and picking-up; or
 - 5.7.2 Operating a rotary brush or broom accompanied or preceded by sufficient wetting to limit VDE to 20% opacity; or
 - 5.7.3 Operating a PM10-efficient street sweeper that has a pick-up efficiency of at least 80 percent as determined by using the Street Sweeper Compliance Testing Method described in South Coast Air Quality Management District Rule 1186 (PM10 Emissions from Paved and Unpaved Roads, and Livestock Operations).
- 5.8 Prevention of carryout and trackout shall be accomplished by:
 - 5.8.1 Installing and maintaining a trackout control device at all access points to paved public roads; or
 - 5.8.2 Maintaining sufficient length of paved interior roads to allow mud and dirt to drop off of vehicles before exiting the site; or
 - 5.8.3 Removing deposits of mud and dirt accumulated on paved interior roads with sufficient frequency to prevent carryout and trackout onto paved public roads.

6.0 Administrative Requirements

6.1 Test Methods

The applicable test methods specified in Rule 8011 shall be used to determine compliance with this rule.

6.2 Recordkeeping

An owner/operator shall comply with the recordkeeping requirements specified in Rule 8011.

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
