

VENTURA COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT

RULE 3 - ADVISORY COMMITTEE

(Adopted 10/22/68, Revised 3/14/95)

- A. The Air Pollution Control Board shall appoint an Air Pollution Control District Advisory Committee to advise and consult with the Board and the Air Pollution Control District on adopting and amending rules and regulations and other matters that the Air Pollution Control Board or Air Pollution Control District may refer to it. The Committee shall consist of twenty members. Two members shall be recommended for appointment by each of the five members of the Ventura County Board of Supervisors, and one member shall be recommended for appointment by each of the ten cities in Ventura County. All Committee members shall be appointed by the Air Pollution Control Board. Advisory Committee members should be skilled and experienced in the field of air pollution control.
- B. The Committee shall select a chairman and vice chairman and such other officers as it deems necessary.
- C. Committee members shall serve without compensation but may be compensated for actual expenses incurred in the discharge of duties related to service on the Committee. The Advisory Committee shall meet as frequently as the Air Pollution Control Board or Committee deem necessary.
- D. In discharging Committee duties, the Committee shall obtain any technical services needed, but any costs for such services must first be approved by the Air Pollution Control Board.
