ENFORCEMENT OF CALIFORNIA'S DIESEL FLEET PROGRAMS

The purpose of this advisory is to inform you that the California Air Resources Board (ARB) regularly initiates random audits of fleets to determine compliance with the Periodic Smoke Inspection Program (PSIP), Solid Waste Collection Program (SWCV), Public Agencies and Utilities Program (PAU), Transit Fleet Vehicle Program (TFV), Transport Refrigeration Units (TRU), and Port/Drayage Truck Program. Fleets found not to be in compliance can be subject to significant civil penalties.
