STATE OF CALIFORNIA NOTICE OF PENDING LAW

ATTENTION HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLE TRANSPORTATION SECTOR

BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2006

If you operate from Mexico, Canada, or any U.S. State into California, you will be required to operate vehicles with engines meeting emissions standards at least as stringent as U. S. federal standards for the model-year that the engine was manufactured.

New California law (AB 1009 of 2004) requires that only heavy-duty vehicles with engines meeting emissions standards at least as stringent as U. S. federal standards will be allowed operation in California.

All heavy-duty commercial vehicles need to have proof that its engine meets emissions standards at least as stringent as U. S. federal standards for its model-year by having a manufacturer emission control label properly affixed on the engine.

Plan now for this new California law.

Contact your engine dealer now to replace missing labels.

This new program will be enforced by the California Air Resources Board (ARB) in cooperation with the California Highway Patrol (CHP).
