Provisions of AB 1811

(June 2006)

- ☞ Alternative fuel vehicles and refueling stations.
- ☞ Alternative fuel production.
- ☞ Research and development.
- ☞ Replace current state vehicle fleet.
- ☞ No fuels derived from petroleum, coke, or coal.
- ☞ Reduce air pollution & greenhouse gases.

Schedule

- ☞ Public meeting: September 21, 2006
- ☞ ARB Board meeting – October 19-20, 2006
- ☞ Solicitations issued about January, 2007
- ☞ Quarterly reports to the legislature.
- ☞ Funds encumbered by June 30, 2007.
- ☞ Funds expended by June 30, 2009.

- ➡ Next step: Concepts to ARB Board


