The Staff of the Air Resources Board (ARB) invites you to a public meeting on April 24, 2002, to discuss the implementation of the Governor's Executive Order to postpone the phaseout of Methyl Tertiary Butyl Ether (MTBE) from California gasoline by one year.

On March 14, 2002, Governor Davis issued Executive Order D-52-02 with the finding that it is not possible to eliminate MTBE from California gasoline on January 1, 2003 without a significant risk of disruption of the availability of gasoline for California consumers, substantial increases in prices, and harming California's economy while imposing an unjustified burden on California motorists. Governor Davis directed the ARB to take the necessary actions to postpone, for one year, the prohibitions of the use of MTBE and other specified oxygenates and related requirements for California Phase 3 Reformulated Gasoline (CaRFG3). The ARB must take action before July 31, 2002.
