

**Other Supporting Documents from Archer Daniels Midland Columbus, Nebraska
Carbon Intensity Adjustment, Revised Pathway**

Archer Daniels Midland Company (ADM) has supplied staff with energy use data, ethanol yield data, and distillers grain production data to substantiate their carbon intensity adjustment for ADM's Columbus, NE dry mill corn ethanol plant. This data is described as a requirement for future unconditional staff recommendation for approval to the executive officer within the staff summary¹. ADM considers the data and supporting information supplied as confidential or trade secret. If other data or information is required from ADM and received by staff to substantiate the pathway CI, as discussed in the staff summary¹, this supporting documentation announcement will be updated accordingly.
