Dear Sir or Madam:

The California Air Resources Board (ARB/Board) staff invites you to attend the first meeting of the 2014 Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS) Advisory Panel (Panel). On April 23, 2009, the Board approved the LCFS regulation. The regulation became effective as of April 15, 2010. Section 95489 of the regulation requires the Executive Officer to conduct two reviews of the LCFS program in a public process. The Executive Officer is also required to convene a Panel with which he will consult on the reviews. The reviews will address a broad range of implementation topics and may include recommended amendments to the regulation. Staff presented the results of the 2011 Panel to the Board in December 2011, and will present the results of the 2014 Panel to the Board by January 1, 2015.

During this meeting, we will review the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act, cover the purpose of the Panel, and conduct a Panel discussion; a tentative agenda is enclosed. Public comments will be taken at the end of the meeting.
