Dear Sir or Madam:

The California Air Resources Board (ARB/Board) staff invites you to attend the second meeting of the Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS) Advisory Panel (Panel). On April 23, 2009, the Board approved the LCFS regulation. The regulation became effective as of April 15, 2010. Section 95489 of the regulation requires the Executive Officer to conduct two reviews of the LCFS program in a public process. The Executive Officer is required to convene a Panel with which he will consult on the reviews. The reviews will address a broad range of implementation topics and may include recommended amendments to the regulation. Staff will present the results of these reviews to the Board by January 1, 2012, and January 1, 2015.

During this meeting, we will discuss the workplan and whether the approach and sources identified in it are adequate to address the pertinent topics. In the interest of time, we expect attendees will have familiarized themselves with the workplan and do not plan on giving a presentation on its contents. Additionally, we will discuss updates on staff's work on Topics 5, 9, and 10 of section 95489 of the LCFS.


