The staff of the California Air Resources Board invites interested parties to participate in the next meeting of the Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS) Electricity Workgroup. This meeting is scheduled to continue discussion on the concept to include electricity from fixed guideway transportation in the LCFS program, and to present a concept to include electric forklifts in the LCFS program. Including electricity from fixed guideway transportation and forklifts in the regulation would expand the applications of electricity transportation fuel that qualify for LCFS credit generation.
