The staff of the California Air Resources Board (ARB/Board) invites interested parties to attend the third meeting of the Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS) Expert Workgroup. The LCFS regulation was approved by the Board at the April 23, 2009 Board hearing. At that hearing, the Board also adopted Resolution 09-31 directing staff to convene an expert workgroup to assist the Board in refining and improving the land use and indirect effects analysis of transportation fuels.

During this meeting of the workgroup, Professor Wally Tyner from Purdue University will present recent Global Trade Analysis Project land use change model updates and the Elasticity Values and Uncertainty subgroups will present interim reports on subgroup activities. 
