Re: 20-4-3: Public Meeting to Hear an Informational Update on the 2020 Mobile Source Strategy

Chair Nichols and Members of the Board:

On behalf of the Center for Community Action & Environmental Justice, East Yard Communities for Environmental Justice, and Earthjustice, we write regarding the 2020 Mobile Source Strategy Update. We encourage CARB to continue course in passing life-saving, zero-emission regulations to tackle pollution from California's largest sources of air pollution, in addition to pursuing new regulations that advance zero-emissions in other sectors.

The 2020 Mobile Source Strategy is an important roadmap for fulfilling the dramatic cuts in emissions needed to meet clean air standards and address toxic risk to communities throughout California. CARB plays a critical role in catalyzing the zero-emission technologies that are required to achieve these cuts, and we ask the Board members to direct staff to expeditiously push adoption of regulations to advance zero-emissions in sectors like trucking, locomotives, shipping, construction, and many others. We also ask Board members to reiterate the great need to continue course in meeting existing commitments to control pollution from sectors like ships at berth, transportation refrigeration units, advanced clean trucks, and harbor craft.
