Chapter 4: On-Road Heavy-Duty Vehicles

AED strongly supports the changes that CARB has proposed to increase the definition of "small fleet" from ten or fewer vehicles to twenty or fewer vehicles for purposes of determining increased funding amounts of up to 80% of vehicle cost. This expanded flexibility will serve to enable small fleets, that are often family-owned or small businesses, to participate in the Carl Moyer Program and accommodate the additional costs for a zero-emission vehicle that they were previously bearing directly. The Carl Moyer Program has been critical to the reduction of transportation emissions in California through the infrastructure projects it has funded. CARB's proposed changes to the program enhance the flexibility and the impact of these funds, we thank you for the opportunity to comment on these important proposed revisions and look forward to ongoing collaboration with CARB to reduce carbon emissions.
