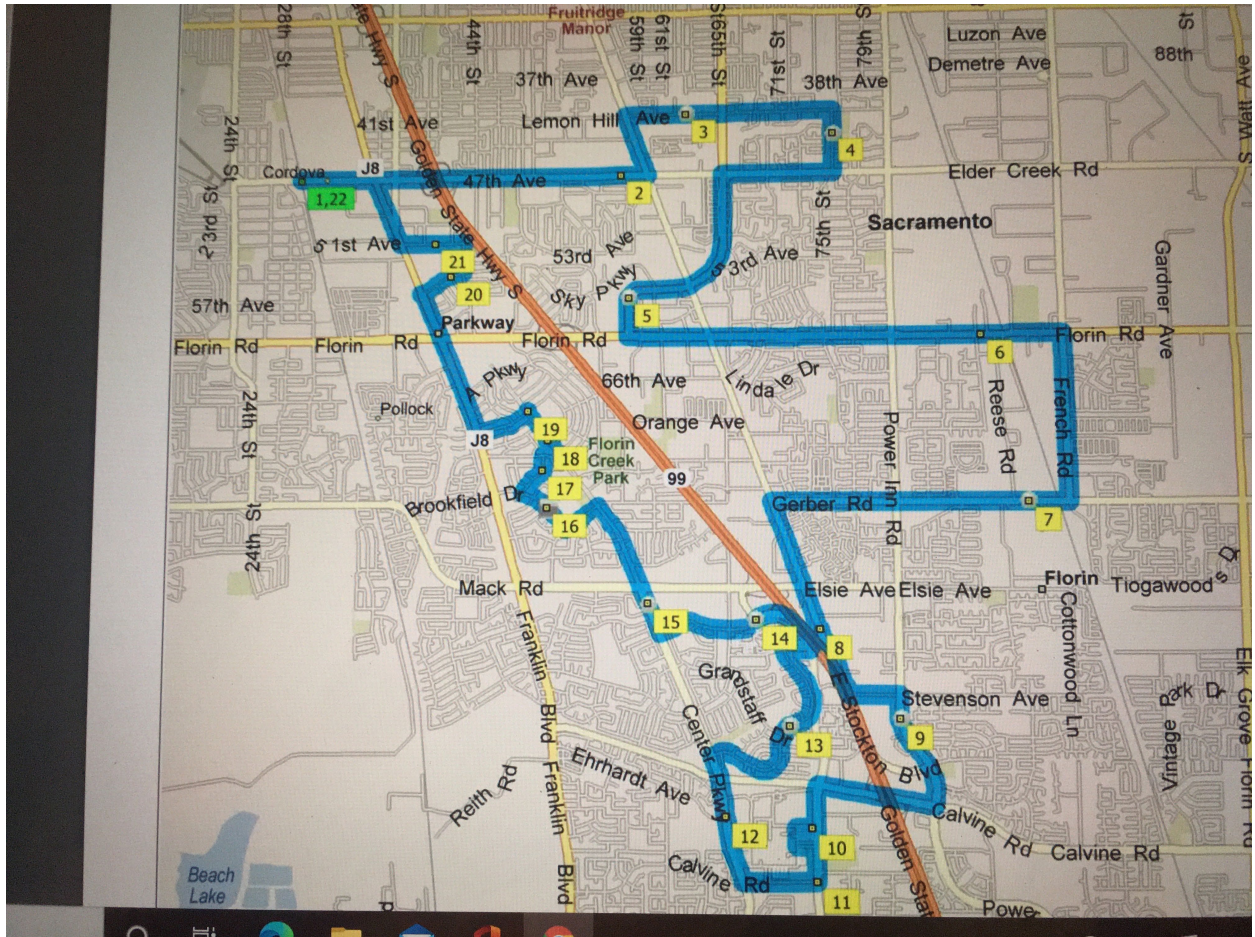

Comments on AB 477 map revisions

Congratulations on another year of AB 477 and associated funding. We see the Board financing will be flat with respect to AB 477's amount. However, you should know that AB 477 is primarily supporting a change in Power plant across the river from South Sacramento's AB 477 community. This community was not made aware of this, and I've CUSA through, despite tracking and significant consultation with them. Do you envision a scenario where they don't get CUSA or Cap & Trade credits? This is the same location as a T-10 facility that managed to escape AB 477 scrutiny, because the boundaries stopped across the river from it. The air district fought for that. The problem is the shared power system (whether it be directly or via a third party) from the California River. The transmission map shows 70% for that of the basin. His home is, equally, tracked by more pollution than 90% of the AB 477 area. The same amount of AB 477, at the average in power plant.
