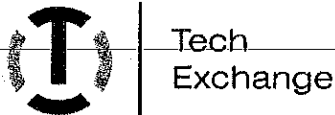

Dear Chair Nichols and Members of the California Air Resources Board:

We are community-based organizations (CBOs) experienced in reaching out to Disadvantaged Communities and promoting Digital Inclusion. We know first-hand the challenges of engaging low-income residents in-language and in-culture and have observed how difficult it is for our most vulnerable residents to receive information and public services if they are not online. Low-income unconnected and underconnected households are being left behind at an accelerating pace—unable to participate in most of the economy and literally being disenfranchised from the democracy. Thus, we commend and greatly appreciate your focus on Disadvantaged Communities and commitment to “equity” in the Draft Third Investment Plan. However, we also respectfully underscore that we don’t think it is possible to achieve the “equity” you seek without also embracing strategies for Digital Inclusion in every investment from the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund (GGRF) as delineated by the California Emerging Technology Fund (CETF).

We are grateful for the time that your staff has taken to read our Comments and meet with us to listen to our perspectives on the importance of Digital Inclusion. We are submitting this letter and testifying before you to urge you to go beyond that proposed Response in the Revised Draft Plan to embrace Digital Inclusion and to strongly encourage GGRF recipients and grantees to incorporate broadband deployment and adoption into 45545 programs and projects.



This Investment Plan will govern GGRF investments for the next 3 years and determine whether or not all State Agencies and grantees pull together to get connected all residents in Disadvantaged Communities so they can contribute to reducing greenhouse gas emissions and achieving the State's Goals. Your visionary leadership is key to advancing Digital Inclusion at this moment in time. We urge bold action now.
