Dear California Air Resource Board Members,

I urge to Board to enact and enforce an Advanced Clean Truck rule that requires that by 2030 \*at least\* 30% (preferably more) of the new trucks on California's roads are all electric, zero emission vehicles.

While we are currently going through the COVID-19 crisis, we must continue to look out for crises in the future, of which climate change is still one despite reports of reduced emissions due to the temporary shelter-in-place policies.

Change sometimes requires pushes from regulatory bodies to shake up the inertia of so-called "tried and true ways." Requiring more zero-emission cars will drive manufacturers to spend resources on research and development, which can potentially spread away from its direct uses. Just as the microwave oven came from radar technology, encouraging ZEVs can spread technologies such as better batteries, which can further encourage electric vehicles and reduce emissions. And the future of the economy is via green-technology, not the old oil companies.
