for Ocean-Going Vessels At Berth**

Hi, I am writing to urge CARB to approve the rule that would extend its pollution-control requirements to many more container and cruise ships and, for the first time, include oil and chemical tankers and ships used to import and export cars.

Bay Area air quality is already seriously threatened by the dramatically increasing frequency of wildfires – disasters that are out of our control. All the more reason that we should do everything we can in our power to immediately reduce toxins in our air – especially those generated by the production of fossil fuels – the burning of which further degrades the air we breathe.
