Please share my comments on this rule with Chair Nichols, the California Air Resource Board Members, and Staff:

I ask that the California Air Resource Board (CARB) please enact and enforce an Advanced Clean Truck (ACT) rule that requires that by 2030, at least 30% of the new trucks on Californiaï $_{\dot{c}}$ ^{1/2}s roads are all electric, zero emission vehicles. Ideally, you would set the target much higher than 30%.

This is important both to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, which are such a threat to our environment, and also to reduce the particulate matter that puts the health of all our residents at risk.

With the recent shutdowns, the difference in the air quality has been very apparent. As traffic ramps up again, we'll lose this temporary improvement and return to hazy skies. Please implement a strong rule, so that at least by 2030, 10 long years from now, we might begin to get a hint of clear, blue skies again.
