I commend the hard work done by the board and staff in drafting the Climate Scoping Plan and the incorporation of some of the points made by the Environmental Justice Advisory Committee. Additional modifications are needed to the Plan to make it effective in meeting California's carbon-neutrality goals, as follows:

- Engineered Carbon Capture: This strategy relies on ineffective and risky methods. Instead, the plan should only support natural carbon sequestration.
- Refinery Pollution: The plan needs to account for all emissions, including those tied to all refinery products sent out of state.
- Public Health: The draft plan's health impact analysis is inadequate. A Public Health Advisory Group needs to be established immediately.
